

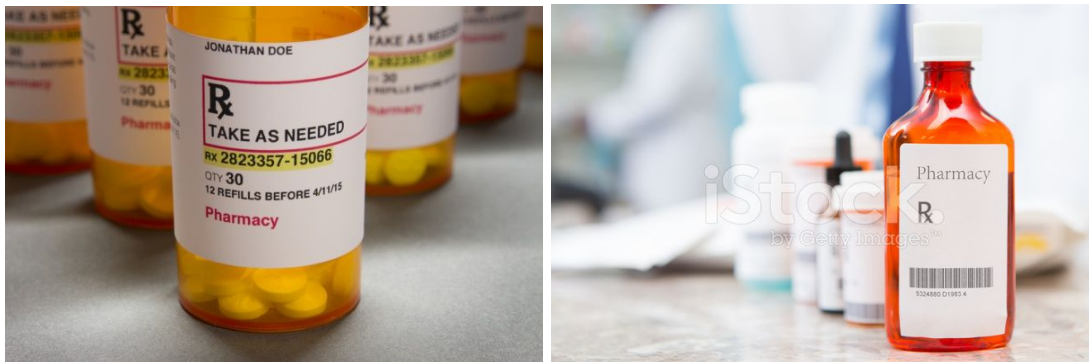
Instructions for Prescription Medications

If your child takes a prescription medication, please organize the medication they will need as noted below and make sure and double check to bring all medications with you. Please put medications in a completely separate bag as they will be checked in upon arrival and distributed during the weekend under supervision of a full-time, on-site LPN.

- The easiest way to distribute medications is to ask your pharmacy to put a weekend supply of your camper's medication in blister packs. (See photos below). Some pharmacies will do this for free if you ask about it.



- If you are unable to get your medications packaged in this way please keep them in their original bottles with just enough medication for the entire weekend (see pictures below). **Please do not put medications in individual envelopes.** Liquid medications should be kept in original bottles.



- Items such as inhalers and epipens should be sent if the child has them even if they do not use them on a regular basis (label = "PRN")
